1939:	Kosei Komusho, a machine design office, established in Kamata, Tokyo
March 1957:	Automated machinery design office Daini Machinery Industry founded in Kamiboyama, Ueda City
1960:	Processing and assembly factory established in current location in Uedahara, Ueda City
June 1961:	Reorganized as Nishida Technical Industry Co., Ltd., with a capital of two million yen
1968 to 1976:	Increased capital, purchased adjacent land, and constructed three new factory buildings
November 1974:	Introduced first numerical control machine tool (machining center) YBM-80NR machining center produced by Yasuda Precision Tools
1975 and beyond:	Continued to introduce machining centers and numerical control machine tools
May 1984:	Constructed administration and welfare building (357 m ²)
January 1986:	Increased capital to 21.75 million yen
May 1988:	Aoki Factory—an injection molding machine assembly line— completed (1,767 m ²)
February 1995:	Fusetsu Nishida appointed president and representative director
